4. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

1. SCRUTINEERING
Scrutineering for this Meeting will be in accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the Rules. In accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2018 KA Manual, each Kart shall have affixed to it a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the Meeting. This signifies that the driver has confirmed their entry for the Meeting and completed a Scrutineering Form relevant to the Entry. As from Friday the Grid Marshal / Scrutineers shall not permit any Kart that does not display a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark to Practice, Qualify or Race
2. ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING
Each engine and chassis must be sealed and tagged in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6.
3. TYRE POOLING & TYRE MARKING
Tyre Pooling Will Not be used at this Meeting.
All Competitors are required to have White Barcoded Tyres for this Meeting. <u>Race Tyres must be presented for scanning before Qualifying at the appropriate time.</u> Tyre scanning will be conducted between 6:30am and 7:30am on Friday, 4 May 2018 for Micro Max, Mini Max and Junior Max Practice Tyre Scanning. All Classes Race Tyre Scanning will be conducted between 12:00pm and 2:00pm on Friday, 4 May 2018.
If the Track is declared Wet, Competitors will be required to present their Wet Weather Tyres for marking as directed by Officials.

5. CIRCUIT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

2. KART RETRIEVAL
Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Track during Qualifying and Racing. Retrieval is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Pit Crew must only enter the Track when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso. Karts can be retrieved via the In-Grid
3. SECURITY
Security will be provided from Thursday 3 rd to Sunday 6 th May 2018. Security will be onsite from 6pm each day
4. TRADE AREAS
